



Park Smart • Park Safe

It only takes a moment of thoughtlessness for an accident to occur. Please be vigilant when driving, stopping or parking near our school to ensure the safety of all our families.

While it may be well known that you can't **park** on yellow zig-zag lines, you also can't **wait** or even **stop momentarily** to drop off or pick up passengers, according to the UK Highway Code.

Highway Code Rule 238

You **MUST NOT** wait or park on **yellow lines** during the times of operation shown on nearby time plates.

Rule 243

DO NOT stop or park near a school entrance. Please do not pull into the school driveway to drop off your children, including for breakfast and after school clubs. This is within the **prohibited yellow zig zag zone** and also involves crossing the path of pedestrians and cyclists which increases risk to our families.

Rule 244

Parking on the pavement can obstruct and seriously inconvenience pedestrians, people in wheelchairs or with visual impairments and people with prams or pushchairs.

Please **DO NOT** stop or park on the pavement to drop children off to school, including those attending breakfast and after school clubs.

PLEASE SLOW DOWN: Remember that young children new to the school run will still be learning to cross safely. A little patience could save a life.

PLEASE LOOK OUT FOR: Pedestrians, including little ones who might not be clearly visible when crossing between parked cars, cyclists, scooters, wheelchairs and buggies.
