



Breaking the Cycle of Poverty

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to tell you that we have **successfully** completed our cycle challenge and have managed to cycle the equivalent of **6,600** (and an extra 15 miles than needed). This is the distance from Exmouth to Kibera in Kenya.

This has been completed by:

- Children and families riding their bikes in the evenings and weekends
- Children cycling on the static bikes in the school hall during lunchtimes and PE slots.
- The EYFS children circling the playground on bikes and trikes
- Staff cycling on the static bikes (even during assemblies!)
- Staff cycling to and from school.

The challenge was launched on Saturday 14th January and took a bit longer than the planned 10 days but we made it in the end, showing real courage and determination!

Thank you to everyone who has taken part and to all those who have donated so far. We have raised **£341** to date and this money will be going to the **Bright Hope Education Centre** in Kibera to support the education of children to help break the cycle of poverty.

This has felt like the longest challenge but we are so proud to have achieved our end goal and once again want to thank you for all of your amazing support.
