Working with Withycombe Raleigh Primary School

Supporting Equal Access to Education

We are working in partnership with the Period Mission Team, a Lymington Methodist Church outreach project for schools in the Exmouth area, to fight period poverty and support equal access to education.

Families who would like to have sanitary products provided for their daughters at this school can either email us at PMT@wrpschool.org to arrange collection of their preferred products, or pupils can go discretely with their school bag to a designated place and access what they need. Supplies will be offered for that period and a supply for the following month to take home.

This is not means-tested as there are various reasons that families might need to access this provision. **Our main aim is that menstruation is not a reason for a child to be missing out on education.** This includes wider education, so families are welcome to holiday supplies too, such as tampons for swimming.

At Withycombe Raleigh Primary School we will set aside a discreet area for those who need to access sanitary products, and we will inform the children where they can find this. Posters will be displayed in the KS2 toilets reminding them where they can go.
