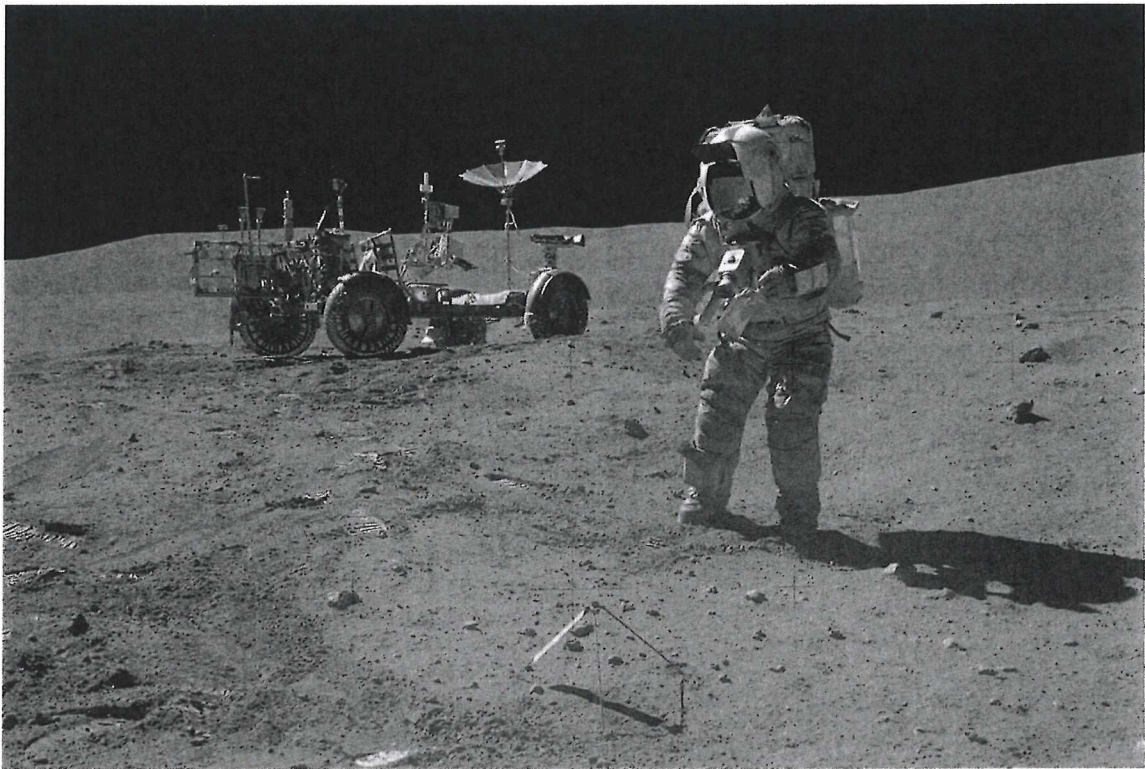
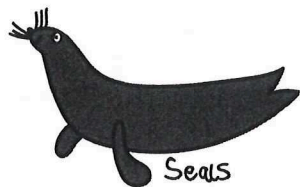

Welcome to Year 2

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to welcome you and your family to Year 2 and reassure you that our main focus in the Autumn Term will be your child's well-being. We have put together a pack of learning for you – we would love to see these when we return to school. Please support your child with the reading and writing of these tasks, you may also want to scribe or label for them – we hope it will be a fun thing to do. You may do as much or as little as you like.

In the Autumn Term we have some lovely topics to cover linking to the overarching theme of space – '*We are astronauts!*'. Within this we will be looking at materials, historical events, drawing and painting skills in Art and Design Technology. Through these topics we will be developing the children's questioning skills as well as capturing their enthusiasm and imagination. If you have any resources or areas of expertise please let us know.

Your child will need to come into school ready for the day ahead. Each day they will need to have:

- Correct school uniform – please label all items including shoes! Please ensure long hair is tied back.

- Book bags

Please ensure that your child's (**named!**) PE kit is always kept in school from Monday to Friday. Outdoor PE kits need to be worn when the weather cools down. The children may wear a tracksuit/ sweater and joggers. Please also include a pair of PE socks in your child's kit. It may be that the children do not change into their full PE kits, just their trainers. This allows for the maximum amount of time to be spent taking part in physical activity.

We are very much looking forward to teaching your child this year and hope they are excited about the year ahead. Please contact us if you have any questions about any aspect of your child's school life, as we will be only too pleased to discuss this. Please also let us know if there is anything happening at home which could be affecting your child's educational progress, as it is important that we are aware of your child's needs.
