

Year 3. Spring Term.

Maths

Multiplication and division:

Multiples of 10, related calculations, reasoning about multiplication, multiplying 2-digit by 1-digit numbers (with and without exchanging), linking multiplication and division and divide a 2-digit by 1-digit number (without exchanging and with partitioning).

Length and perimeter:

Measure in mm, cm, and m, find equivalent lengths, compare lengths and add lengths.

Literacy

Persuasive adverts:

To identify the features of adverts and create an advert for their own product.

Narnia:

Create characters and a plot, describe setting, use adjectives to modify nouns, use conjunctions to express time, use prepositions and use fronted adverbials with a comma.

Grammar focus: Use of headings and subheadings. Using the present perfect form of verbs. Inverted commas to punctuate direct speech. Terminology: preposition, conjunction, word family, prefix, clause, subordinate clause, direct speech, consonant, vowel, inverted commas.
