Geography

Seaside

How is the seaside different from other places?
How do people enjoy themselves at the seaside?
Learning all about Wembury & Exmouth beach.

Music

This term the children will be introduced to pitch by exploring high and low sounds through singing, listening and playing simple instruments. Children will also be introduced to simple musical notation, helping them recognise and understand basic symbols for rhythm and sound

History

How have explorers changed the world?
In this unit children learn about famous explorers such as Dame Ellen MacArthur, Matthew Henson, Mary Kingsley and Christopher Columbus. They explore where these individuals travelled, what they discovered and why they were important.

RE

What does it mean to belong to a faith in the community?

The children will also have the opportunity to learn about the Muslim Jewish & Christian faith and how people live. This will include retelling stories and thinking about celebrations.

How should we care for the world & for others & why does it matter?

What do people believe about caring for others & what do they believe about the beginning of the world.

Art

The children will be exploring sculptures and using paper to apply their paper shaping skills to make an imaginative sculpture. We will look at famous artists and exploring the different techniques they use when creating paper sculptures such as curving, spiralling and zig-zagging.

PE

The children will be learning about orienteering. Where they will be working together as a team to following instruction and problem solve. The children will also be developing their ball skills by focusing on sending and returning. We will be practising lots of relay races and fun activities in preparation for our summer sports day.

RSE

The children will be emersed in the unit 'Safety & the changing body' when they will be discussing, how to stay safe in everyday situations including at home, outdoors and online, while learning to identify trusted adults who can help them. We will be focusing on transition to Year 2 by exploring the unit 'Aiming High'.
