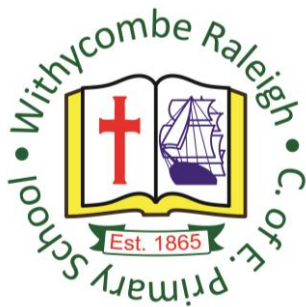

News from your Headteacher

I hope that you have all had a lovely week and I am sure you all are looking forward to the weekend.

Mr Scudder and some of our Ethos Council visited Exmouth Foodbank last week. The children went to look at where our donations go and how the volunteers support families in need. Felix and Hannah from Sandpiper Class, have written a short article for our newsletter to let you all know more about the Ethos Council and the work of the Foodbank.

The Ethos Council

The Ethos Council is made up of two people from each class (42 in total) who try and make the school and the world a better place.

Foodbank Trip

On 2nd November, Withycombe Raleigh C of E Primary School sent their Ethos Council to the Exmouth Foodbank to learn about how they give food to people who need it. We walked in pairs to the Foodbank. The Foodbank uses the Salvation Army building on Tuesdays and Fridays to distribute food. The volunteers told us about the work of the volunteers and then we helped them by doing some of their jobs they do: sorting food donations according to 'use by' date; packing bags of food for families and menu planning.

Felix said 'I think the Foodbank is a very good and generous place and they like to think about other people. The people who volunteer there made me feel very happy and welcome.'

If you wish to donate items to the foodbank you can drop items here at the school office or donate in one of the local drop off points in supermarkets.

Family Fund.

During the pandemic, following requests from several parents, we set up the Withycombe Family Fund. This fund was set up to support families who had been affected financially due to the pandemic. Many of the families we have supported were not entitled to universal credit as they were working but were struggling to make ends meet each month. The Family Fund has helped many of our families and it has funded: vouchers to buy food at Christmas, school shoes, subsidised residential visits, to name just a few of the ways our school community has helped. Although the pandemic is 'over', we still have families who are struggling financially, especially with the cost of living increasing so dramatically. Families who are able to, can still donate to the fund via Parentpay if they would like to do so – and this is of course is hugely appreciated. I have recently received the following communication from another headteacher regarding the financial crisis for schools. Mr Hitchcock is trying to get 100,000 signatures so the issue can be debated in Parliament.

You may have seen in the news that two thirds of schools will be in deficit by the end of this financial year. This is through no fault of their own. Costs are rising and funding is lower than it was a decade ago. The current funding increase and energy bill relief scheme will not be enough to prevent further cut-backs. This will greatly harm our education system and pupils.

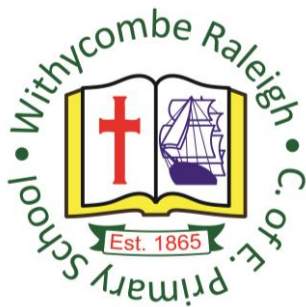

Safeguarding: Anti-Bullying Week

Anti-Bullying Week (coordinated by the Anti-Bullying Alliance). Will take place next week between 14th to 18th November. This year's theme is 'Reach Out' – reaching out and showing each other the support needed to stand up against bullying. The message to children this year is to encourage them to reach out to someone they trust if they need to talk (both people at home and school staff). Children will also be encouraged to reach out to someone they might know who is being bullied.

Bullying can affect children's lives and at its worst, it can leave them feeling hopeless. At school we do our best to educate and empower children to do something positive to counter the hurt that bullying causes. We recognise that it can take an enormous amount of courage (one of our school values) to challenge it. Our children will explore scenarios next week and use role play in order to learn how to act and what to say in situations involving incidents of bullying.

It is arguably more difficult for children to escape cyberbullying – please continue to teach your child how to get help, where to report cyberbullying and options for reaching out to talk to someone.

The ABA point out that we all have a responsibility to help each other reach out and challenge bullying by reflecting on our own behaviour, setting positive examples and creating a kinder community.

We would love our school community to kick off the week with **Odd Socks Day** on Monday (14th) where adults and children are invited to support Anti-Bullying Week by wearing odd socks to celebrate what makes us all unique. All children (or adults) have to do to take part is wear odd socks to school. 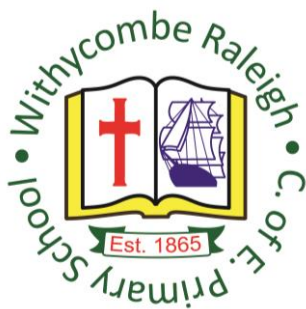

Elle has passed her level 3 swimming and is now in level 4

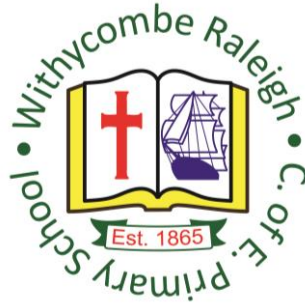
Joe and Benji Beech class: Players of the match.

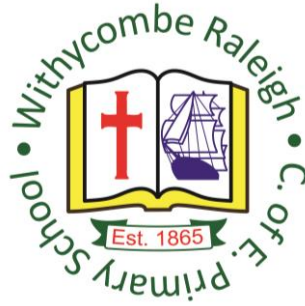

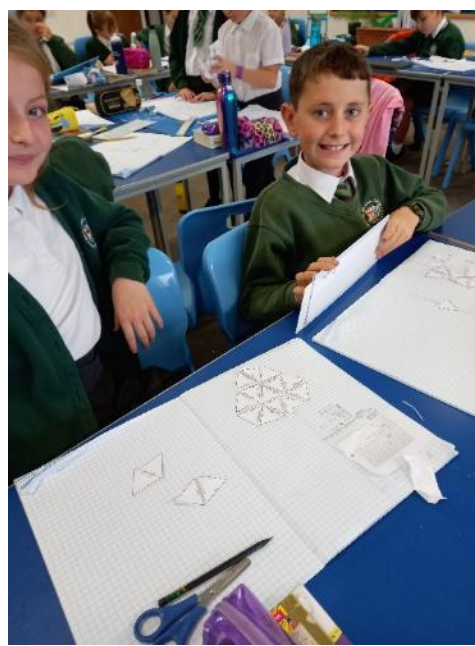

(Rabbit Class)

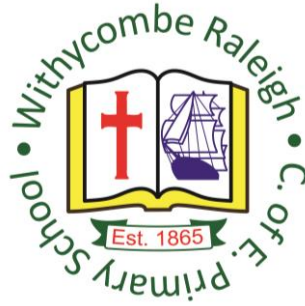
In year 5 maths this week we have had to use our knowledge of multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 to solve a difficult jigsaw puzzle!
