Collective Worship

This week we have celebrated the Queen's Platinum Jubilee in our Collective Worship sessions. We have looked at how the UK has changed over the 70 years of her reign and heard about some of the technological advances during that time.



Safeguarding



Yubo is a social networking app which is surging in popularity. Like many apps in this bracket, you must be over 13 to join, although the App Store rate it as 17+. Those aged 13 to 18 years old must have parental permission and will join a separate Yubo community that is only for under-18s.

The app is designed for users to make 'friends' by swiping right on someone's profile picture and if they do the same on yours then you can chat with them or stream live videos (like some of the adult dating apps).

Despite the fact that Yubo have created guides to help make it a safer environment for your child, it will come as no surprise that a child using this app may come across content that is not appropriate to them. The Sunday Times have recently carried out an independent investigation and found that young users had been exposed to sexual harassment, racism and bullying, with some chats referencing self-harm and drug use. Children can also launch live video streams with which strangers can interact via real time text chat. The thought of strangers watching children's livestreams and being able to potentially locate them is particularly worrying!

There are also real concerns about children's self-esteem and emotional wellbeing, if for example a child's profile is continually 'declined' by others using the swiping function.
