





## RE

This half term in RE we will be thinking about what it means to belong to a Faith Community. They will be comparing Christian and Jewish traditions as well as what Christians believe God is like.

## Literacy

We will continue to focus on building up the skills needed to be a good writer. We will be reading and looking at the following books:

Fiction – children to create their own version of Dino Dinner By Mick Manning

Fiction – Town Mouse Country Mouse- inspires some great imagination and story telling!

Non-Fiction – we write our own Dino Fact Files based on Creature Features

Instruction writing- How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth.

## History

During this term the children will be learning about what we mean by 'history maker' and famous history makers. Within this, we will be paying attention to and studying the local historic figure Mary Anning and the importance of her life. They will start to learn where people and events fit within a chronological framework and begin to use a range of vocabulary of historic terms (e.g. before, after, a long time ago, past).

The children will be encouraged to ask and answer questions to understand some of the ways in which we find out about the past.

## PE

We will be developing movements including team games using skills of attack, defend and shoot.

We will continue to use apparatus to develop our skills in gymnastics to perform a sequence of moves. We will also be learning new skills in dance.

## Science

The children will be learning about Animals and observing changes across the four seasons. Children will look at how and why to care for our planet. They will also begin to explore plant growth.

## Computing

The children will learn about 'Digital Writing', using a keyboard and exploring text as well as using their programming and coding skills to move a robot.

## DT

For DT the children will be exploring textiles to design and make their own puppet based on a Traditional Tale. The children will evaluate their finish product.

## Music

The children will be using their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes. They will focus on pace and pitch.

## Computing

The children will learn how to program a digital robot and how to use a device to produce digital writing.

## Art

The children will be developing lots of different skills to support them in colour mixing. They will look at a range of techniques in using colour, pattern and texture and explore the work of artists to inspire their final pieces

## Maths

The children will gain a more secure knowledge of numbers to 50, counting on and back from any number. They will also be counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. They will consolidate their understanding of place value and how to represent numbers in different ways. In geometry the children will learn about 2D and 3D shape and pattern, position and direction.

## Geography

The children will learn about the Geography of where we live. They will learn to locate our school on an ariel photograph.

They will create a map of the classroom and locate key features of our playground and outside areas. They will talk about how our playground makes them feel and create a design to improve our outdoor spaces.

## RSE

The children will learn about working as a TEAM; listening to others kindness, empathy, teasing and bullying. We will also be exploring 'Britain' and thinking about our community and country.
