## News from your Headteacher

It's Half Term...I hope that you all have a lovely week away from school and we will look forward to welcoming everyone back on 31<sup>st</sup> October. Although children and staff are ready for half term break, everyone has settled into the new routines brilliantly and school feels a very happy and calm place. We have certainly crammed a lot into the past 6 weeks, and this week has been no exception. This week Year 2 enjoyed visiting the Space Dome, Year 4 participated in some singing workshops, 3 groups have been swimming, Year 5 spent the day as Vikings, KS2 had a visitor from Kenya, Parents' Evenings and we launched our Christmas Shoebox appeal. We are a very busy school and there is always lots of exciting activities and learning going on.

### Hope4Kibera

Over the past two years we have developed a great friendship with the Hope4Kibera charity, which aims to improve the lives of children living in Africa's biggest urban slum, Kibera in Nairobi, Kenya. We have held some great initiatives to raise money for the charity which has helped provide food parcels for families in Kibera and books for The Bright Hope Education Centre, which is a secondary school on the outskirts of Kibera.

On Monday 17th October KS2 were delighted to meet Peter Abungu who was visiting the UK from Kenya. Peter explained a bit about what life is like for families living in Kibera, which is home to around 800,000 people living in dire poverty. Children asked some great questions about how students were selected to attend the Bright Hope School, and what food they typically eat. They were saddened to learn that often there is not enough food for everyone in the family to eat on the same day.



We are planning a static cycle challenge in January with the aim of raising money to help 'break the cycle of poverty through education'. The plan is to take turns on some exercise bikes to cover the distance from Exmouth to Kibera - that's about 6,500 miles!

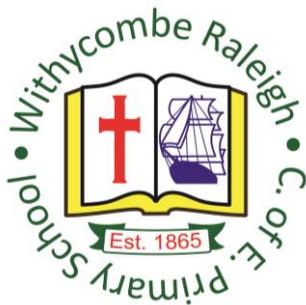

### Our School Parent Support

In our school we regularly run evidence based parent support groups and courses. Below is some brief information of what we offer.

The courses are open to any parent or carer to attend.

The Solihull Approach Parenting Group will start after Christmas. This 10 week course aims to help parents and carers understand more about their child's behaviour, and learn more about sensitive and effective parenting. It can help parents with children experiencing any emotion or behaviour.

The Timid to Tiger Parent Course will run after Easter. Designed by clinical psychologists specialising in childhood anxiety, this course is for parents who want to learn how to help manage their child's anxiety or to increase their child's confidence.


Winnie (Rabbits) was awarded Player of the Week at football.
